Magnesium lactate is the magnesium salt of lactic acid, which is obtained by bringing about a chemical reaction. It is an odorless white powder or granular material.

Magnesium lactate is easily soluble in water. Magnesium lactate is used in the areas of pharmaceuticals, foods and food supplements.

Further properties and applications: acidity regulator, mineral fortification in beverages e.g. milk, water, juices, spritzers, soft drinks.
