Depending on the sodium atoms bonded in the molecule, sodium phosphate occurs as monosodium phosphate, disodium phosphate and trisodium phosphate.</p> <p>In the food industry sodium phosphate is used as sequestrant, acidity regulator, emulsifying salt or solidifying agent.</p> <p>Sodium phosphate is used in the areas of foods, food supplements and pharmaceuticals.</p>
